What does it mean to care for our bodies, ourselves, and each other in times of personal and collective pain?

Audio and Graphic Versions

The **audio** is an intimate 30-minute headphone experience, written and performed by **Sarah Hopfinger** with composition from **Alicia Jane Turner**.

The **graphic score** is an original visual artwork designed by **Rachel O'Neill** and **Michaela Pointon,** created in response to the live and audio versions of *Pain and I*.

The score documents the different elements of the performance - text, movement, and music composition — to create a unique visual experience. Existing both as a digital document (online) and printed publication (physical), the graphic score creatively explores and shares the qualities and intentions of *Pain and I*.

Both the audio and graphic score can be experienced from your home, or anywhere you wish. They can be experienced by those who have not seen the live performance, as well as existing as support materials for audiences to experience before/after the performance.
